Class 1 Q	OPEN NOVICE Combination of horse and handler not to have won two first prior to entries closing. Any age, type, height, or sex.
Class 2 Q	OPEN YOUNGSTOCK Born 2007, 2008 or 2009. Any type, height, sex or colour. Qualifiers for three highest placed not exceeding 153cms at maturity and those to exceed 153cms at maturity
Class 3 Q	OPEN PONY. Not to exceed 153cm and age type or sex. Rosette to the highest placed youngstock 3 years or under
Class 4Q	OPEN HEAVYWEIGHTS/COBS/ TRADITIONALS/ VANNERS Any age, type, height, sex. Special to highest placed youngstock.
Class 5Q	OPEN LIGHT/MIDDLEWEIGHTS Any age, type, height, sex. Special to highest placed youngstock.
Class 6Q	BSPA INHAND VETERAN STAR SERIES . Sec a) 15-20 Sec b) 21-25 Sec c) 26+ First two in each section qualify Open to members and non-members. Judged on condition turnout and display Will be judged as one class.. Any type or sex
Class 7Q	BEST COLOUR & MARKINGS Skewbalds & Piebalds only. 90% Colour and markings 10% Judges choice. Additional qualifier to highest placed overo. Rosette to the highest placed blue eyes
Class 8Q	BRIGHTWELL AUCTIONEERS SPORTS HORSE YOUNGSTOCK In Hand sport horse youngstock Skewbald or Piebald horse or pony colt, filly or gelding any height not exceeding 3 years old. Open to members with registered horse/pony only (Stallions must be licensed and graded with the BSPA).(Refer to rules regarding eligibility to enter)
Class 9Q	BRIGHTWELL AUCTIONEERS OPEN SPORTS HORSE & PONIES In Hand Skewbald & Piebald horse or pony 4 – 8 years old any height open to mares, geldings or stallions Open to members with registered horse/pony only (Stallions must be licensed and graded with the BSPA).).(Refer to rules regarding eligibility to enter)

Class 10 Q	OPEN LEAD REIN OR FIRST RIDDEN MAY BE JUDGED SEPARATELY Lead Rein ponies not to exceed 12.2 (127cm) Riders 3-8 years (ALL LEADERS MUST BE CORRECTLY DRESSED 16 YEARS AND OVER) Lead rein fixed onto the noseband. First Ridden ponies not exceeding 13.00 (132cm) Riders not exceeding 10 years Open to members and non-members
Class 11 Q BSPA	OPEN NOVICE HORSE OR PONY Any type, sex or colour 4 years and over Judge will not ride. Display required (open to members and non members) In their first season of competition or never to have won 2 firsts. Any suitable snaffle bridle may be worn. No spurs.
Class 12 Q	OPEN HORSE OR PONY Any type, sex or colour 4 yrs and over Judge will not ride. No spurs. Display required. (open to members and non members)
Class 13Q	RIDDEN VETERAN STAR SERIES Sec a) 15-20 yrs Sec b) 21-25 yrs Sec c) 26 yrs + First two in each section qualify Open to members and non-members. Judged on condition turnout and display Will be judged as one class. No spurs. Any type or sex
Class 14 Q	OPEN EQUITATION JUDGED ON 50% HORSE 50% RIDER Special Rosette for the best Junior under 12 years Sec a) Juniors 18 years and under Sec b) Seniors 19+ Highest placed three BSPA Members qualify. Open to members and non-members
Class 15 Q RIHS/BSPA	RIHS Skewbald/Piebald Pony not exceeding 143cms. Any type, sex, 4 years old and over not exceeding 143cms. Rider any age suitable for the pony. The Judge will not ride. . Display required which must include walk, trot, canter and a simple change of canter, gallop and halt. No spurs may be worn
Class 16 Q RIHS/BSPA	RIHS Skewbald/Piebald Pony (Plaited) exceeding 143cm not exceeding 153cms Any sex 4 years old and over. Judge will not ride. Display required which must include walk, trot, canter and a simple change of canter, gallop and halt. No spurs may be worn
Class 17 Q RIHS/BSPA	RIHS Skewbald/Piebald Pony Native, Traditional or Hogged Cob exceeding 143cm not exceeding 153cms Any type, sex, 4 years old and over not exceeding 153cms. Rider any age suitable for the pony. The Judge will not ride. Display required which must include walk, trot, canter and a simple change of canter, gallop and halt. No spurs may be worn.
Class 18 Q RIHS/BSPA	RIHS Skewbald/Piebald Lightweight/Middleweight/Heavyweight Horse exceeding 153cms (Plaited) Any type, sex, 4 years old and over exceeding 153cms. Riders 15 years and older as 1 st January of current year. Judge will ride and may request a display at their discretion.
Class 19 Q RIHS/BSPA	RIHS Skewbald/Piebald Native/Vanner/ Traditional or hogged cob Horse exceeding 153cms Any type, sex, 4 years old and over exceeding 153cms. Riders 15 years and older as 1 st January of current year. Judge will ride and may request a display at their discretion.

AWARDED 1% TO BE ADDED TO THEIR GRADING SCORE IF THEY SUCCESSFULLY

BLUE PREFERRED – FOR THOSE SCORING 65% - 70%

WHITE CERTIFIED – FOR THOSE SCORING 65% OR LESS

Class 20 Skewbald and piebald plaited Horse. Exhibits exceeding or calculated to exceed
153cm at maturity. To be Judged in three categories yearling, two year old, three year old.
Colts and Fillies only.

Class 21 Skewbald and Piebald Native/Traditional/Cob.Exhibits exceeding 153cm or
calculated to exceed 153cm at maturity. To be Judged in three categories yearling, two year
old, three year old. Colts and Fillies only.

Class 22 Skewbald and Piebald plaited pony not exceeding 153cm. . . To be Judged in three
categories yearling, two year old, three year old. Colts and Fillies only

Class 23 Skewbald and Piebald Native/Traditional/Cob not to exceed 153cm at maturity. .
To be Judged in three categories yearling, two year old, three year old. Colts and Fillies only

RULES

Classes will be judged within the rules and criteria of the B.S.P.A, copies can be obtained from them. Please note that you do not have to be a member to compete but you must hold a current membership/horse registration to qualify for the Summer Championships. 1st – 3rd or three highest placed in open classes to qualify.

All Qualification cards MUST be signed in the ring by the class judge in order to be valid..

The Brightwells Auctioneers Skewbald and Piebald Sports Horse and Pony In Hand National Championship Qualifier. These classes are for athletic Horses and Ponies that have the conformation and movement to compete in Dressage, Showjumping or Eventing and that have a **verified/proven parentage passport, breeding must be indicated on the entry form.** The three highest places in each class to qualify for the final to be held at the British Skewbald and Piebald Association World Championships of Colour 28th – 30th August 2010 to be held at The College EC Keysoe, Beds. At the final the Champion will receive £ 50 the Reserve £ 20 Each Horse/Pony is to be judged individually on a triangle and also walked and trotted round the ring as a class. Marks will be awarded for confirmation, walk, trot and overall impression. **Handlers, Owners and Horses/Ponies must be members of the BSPA for qualification to remain valid. These classes are open to BSPA Members with registered Horses/Ponies only.**

Classes 15 – 19 These classes are affiliated to the British Skewbald and Piebald Association and are qualifiers for the Royal International Horse Show at Hickstead on 27 th July 2010. These classes will be judges under BSPA rules, copies of which can be obtained from them. All horses/ponies must be registered with and owners & riders members of BSPA prior to the show. Rider age is taken as 1st Jan. All stallions must be graded and licensed by BSPA. No rider under 14yrs may exhibit a stallion in any class. Membership and Qualification cards MUST be carried in the ring by competitors and produced as required for inspection and signature. Failure to do so will disqualify any competitor and their qualification handed down to the next unqualified competitor. Spurs may not be worn in any pony class. Ponies 153cms or under must possess a current JMB height certificate. Qualification: 1st place and the highest next unqualified competitor standing 2nd or 3rd qualify from each class. No competitor may qualify from lower than 3rd place.

1. Competitors and spectators attend the show at their own risk. The organisers will not be held responsible for any accident, damage, loss or injury to any person, animal or property whatsoever.
2. The judge's decision is FINAL.
3. No entries to be refunded.
4. No lunging in the collecting ring.
5. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry without explanation.
6. Any horse, pony, handler or rider behaving in any way that poses a risk to itself or others will be asked to leave.
7. All colts/stallions must be bitted. **NO EXCEPTIONS, STALLIONS 4 YEARS AND OVER MUST BE GRADED WITH BSPA.**
8. Horses/ponies in ridden classes must be 4 years old and over unless otherwise stated in the schedule
9. Horse/ponies ages are from 1 January
10. Junior riders must wear correctly secured British Standard Riding Hats as EN1384.PAS015 or PAS accredited.
11. Skewbald/Piebald colts/stallions aged 4yrs and over must be licensed or graded with the B.S.P.A to go in showing classes. No rider or handler under 14yrs may exhibit a colt/stallion.
12. Owners/Handlers/Riders/Horses must be members/registered with B.S.P.A to qualify but need not to enter (except classes 8-9 & 15-19 when membership horse registration is required)
13. Spurs or dress spurs must not be worn in any Ridden Pony class. Where a Horse/Pony class are held no exhibitor may wear spurs. - B.S.P.A rule.
14. Dressage whips are forbidden and all whips must be under 30 inches
15. No mucking out into the car park
16. No smoking in arena
17. No dogs except in horsebox area
18. Mobile phones must be turned off in the ring
19. No earrings, tongue studs, or any jewellery may be worn whilst competing
