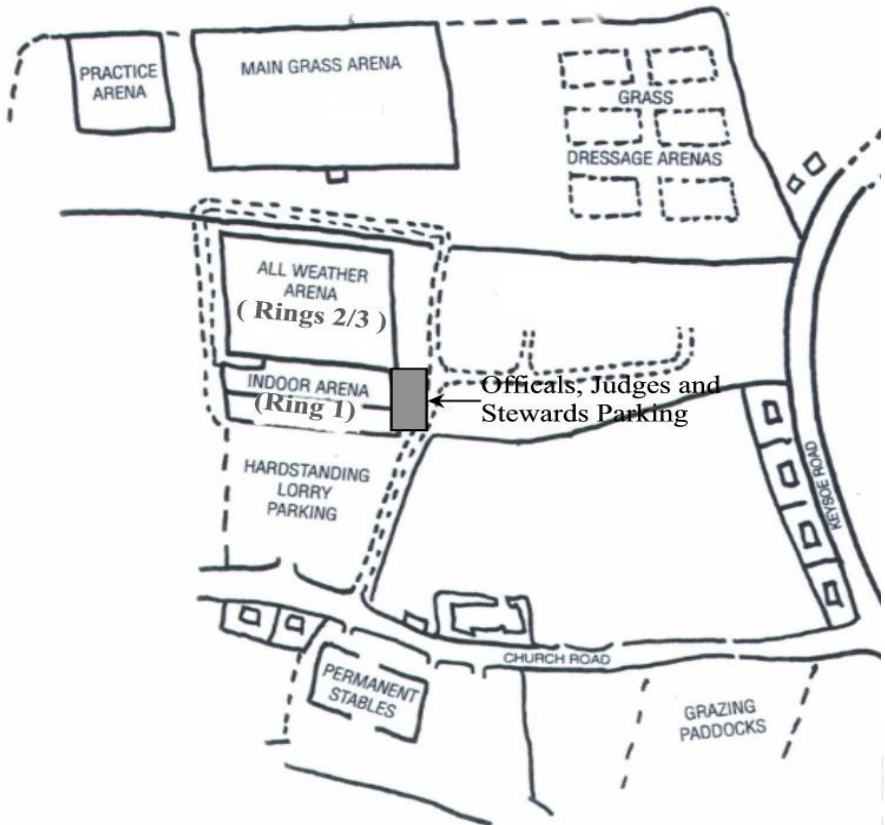

Schedule open to Colts, Fillies, Mares, Stallions and Geldings of any type or colour:

Qualifiers for: -

- ❖ **British Skewbald & Piebald Association (BSPA)** World Championships Of Colour and Royal International Horse Show .
- ❖ **British Show Horse Association.** (BSHA) - Royal International Horse Show and National Championships .
- ❖ **Ponies Association UK (PUK) Registration No. 012/SUM/6751** Summer Championships S02, S17
- ❖ **Equifest** – Summer Championship Show (East of England Show Ground).
- ❖ **ALL** Qualification Cards where issued **MUST** be in the Riders/ Handlers possession **IN THE RING** and given to the Judge to sign **IN THE RING** otherwise Qualification is invalid and will pass to the next unqualified competitor under each Societies rules.
- ❖ **Qualification cards-** are issued by each Association according to their own rules.
- ❖ **Open Classes-** are open to any type or colour of horse/pony, conforming to the class description or requirement re breed type, age or gender.
- ❖ **Prize Money-** Where offered **MUST** be collected at the end of each day (by office closure) or is forfeited. Any uncollected money will be donated to the WHW.
- ❖ **Class Times-** rings will commence at the times shown, thereafter, times are dependent upon class size and Judges progress.
- ❖ **Abbreviations-** HP= Horse/Pony h/p = Highest Placed, NB= Not before, Y/S = Youngstock, WCC- BSPA World Championships of Colour.

Qualification:

- ❖ **BSPA Qualifiers (WCC) -**
1ST-3rd Qualify automatically.
1st-4th Qualify from classes of 10-12
1st-6th Qualify from classes exceeding 12 competitors.
- ❖ **OPEN CLASSES** - The two Highest Placed Skewbald/Piebald qualify BSPA (WCC)
- ❖ **BSHA Novice** - Any Skewbald/Piebald placed 1-6 qualify BSPA (WCC)
- ❖ **BSPA -RIHS** – The 1st placed and the next unqualified competitor standing 2nd or 3rd.
- ❖ **BSHA- RIHS-** Hacks, Cobs and Riding Horses, the 1st in each weight category will qualify. If they have already qualified then the 2nd place may qualify and the 3rd place if 2nd place has already done so.
- ❖ **BSHA- National Championship Show.** 1-3rd prize winners in classes 31,32,34,35 & 40 will qualify for the National Championships Classic Supreme Classes.
- ❖ **Equifest** – The 3 highest placed exhibits not already qualified
- ❖ **P(UK)** 1st, 2nd & 3rd placed exhibit will qualify in classes. Qualification will pass no lower than 3rd place.
- ❖ **BSPA MEMBERS ARE ABLE TO QUALIFY FOR WCC FROM ALL CLASSES IN THIS SCHEDULE AS ABOVE.**

Class Prize Money:

- ❖ Equifest = £10 x 1st where entries exceed 4
- ❖ BSPA RIHS Qualifier Classes = £25 x 1st, £15 x 2nd & £10 x 3rd No prize money is given for classes of 3 or less.
- ❖ BSHA, RIHS - when entries do not exceed 6 = £25 x 1st & £15x 2nd.
When entries exceed 6 then a 3rd prize is offered = £10.

DEFINITIONS:-

BRITISH COLDBLOODS - defined as...

A Horse or Pony that does not have American, Continental, TB or Arab bloodlines within their first and second generation, sire and dam lines unless they are BSPA Stud Book verified, conforming to Part Bred definition below.. The type more usually represents the hardy and thrifty indigenous British stock of Draught, Native and Vanner types and PB's. Requiring significant trimming and tiding unless being shown as a Traditional. Unknown parentage does not confirm any Coldblood origins. More frequently now they will have proven parentage.

PART BRED AND FIRST CROSS BRITISH COLDBLOODS - Verified Breeding

British Coldblood first cross (first generation) horses and ponies **MUST** have a minimum of 50% verified Coldblood breeding from their first generation sire or dam lines. **AND** part bred not less than 60% accumulated via both first and/or second generations. B.S.P.A. Stud Book and Registration records will confirm eligibility and status.

AMATEUR OWNER/PRODUCER/RIDER Ridden & In-Hand.

All Horses or Ponies in this section **MUST** be owned, registered, produced and ridden by the owner or their son/daughter/grandchild/brother/sister. **Nor** must the exhibitor earn their primary living from a stud or other equestrian or competitive discipline. **Nor** must they be a trainer or producer for reward or hire. Horses/Ponies **MUST NOT** have been stabled in a livery since 1st January or stabled with a trainer during 2011 except in the case of a Broodmare. **DIY livery is acceptable.** Exhibitors will be registered Members who have either been issued with a blue amateur status qualification card or who are so classified on the BSPA membership database.

DOPE TESTING Random testing- will occur at this year's Festival.

Any horse/pony identified for testing **MUST** present themselves at the required time in the special area provided. Refer Rule 33 (page 15-17 of Rulebook). Failure to do so will result in immediate disqualification.

4 years and older. Any Type or sex.

Class 4: Skewbald/Piebald Native, Traditional and Cob Ridden Pony not to exceed 153cms.

4 years and older. Any Type or sex.

Class 5: P(UK) Commanchee Section Championship.

First and second from Classes 1 - 4 to compete.

Award: Champion and Reserve Champion.

BSPA WINTER CHAMPIONSHIPS RIDDEN CLASSES

Class 6: Horse or Pony in First Season.

Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, in their first season of ridden showing. Judge will not ride, a short display required. No gallop other than in individual display at the rider's discretion. No reinback is required.

Class 7: Skewbald/Piebald Plaited Pony Types not to exceed 153cms.

Any sex or type. Rider any age suitable for size of pony.

BSPA Traditional Horse & Pony Championship Classes
Class 8 Skewbald/Piebald Traditional no to exceed 133cms.
Any type or sex. Rider any age suitable for size of pony.

Class 9: Skewbald/Piebald Traditional exceeding 133cms not to exceed 143cms.
Any type or sex. Rider any age suitable for size of pony.

Class 10: Skewbald/Piebald Traditional exceeding 143cms.

Class 11: Traditional Horse & Pony Championship.

First and second from classes 8-10 compete.

Awards: Champion Traditional & Reserve Champion go forward to the Supreme Ridden Championship A or B as appropriate..

Class 12: Skewbald/Piebald Ridden Novice Horse and Pony.

Any height or type.

Awards 1-6 incl. Novice Champion Horse, Novice Champion Pony and Novice Coldblood which will be judged concurrently.

Champion Horse Champion Pony and Champion Coldblood go forward to the Supreme Championships .A B or C as appropriate.

Class 13: Skewbald/Piebald Ridden Lightweight/Middleweight exceeding 153cms.

Any sex or type. All exhibits must be plaited. 1st & 2nd go forward to Championship B.

Class 14: Skewbald/Piebald Ridden Heavyweights, Cobs or Vanner Type exceeding 153cms.

Any sex or type. Exhibits may be hogged or plaited. 1st & 2nd go forward to Championship B.

Class 15: Skewbald/Piebald British Coldblood Horse or Pony.

Any type or sex, exhibits may be hogged but not plaited. 1st & 2nd go forward to Championship A or B as appropriate.

Class 16: Ridden 4 & 5-Year-Old Horses & Pony Championship.

Mare/Stallion/Gelding – Equine age as taken Jan 1st . Snaffle Bridles Only. Rein Back NOT required.

Awards: 1st – 6th including Best Horse, Best Pony, Best Coldblood.
Best Horse, Pony & Coldblood go forward to supreme Championships A B or C

Class 17: Ridden Mare Pony and Horse.

Awards to Best Pony, Best Horse and Best Cold Blood.

Class 18: Ridden Gelding Pony and Horse.

Awards to Best Pony, Best Horse and Best Coldblood.

Class 19: Ridden BSPA Graded Stallion Pony and Horse.

Awards to Best Pony, Best Horse and Best Coldblood.

1st & 2nd from classes 17-19 incl go forward to Championship A B or C as appropriate

Grooms entering the ring **MUST** be dressed in accordance with BSPA General Showing Rule 69. Failure to comply with the dress code will result in their ejection from the ring and may result in the exhibit they are attending being disqualified. Refer Rule Book Rules 68/69 Page 22.

The videoing (by any means including the use of mobile phones) of any class or animal whilst competing in a class is forbidden unless permission has been sought from the Show Directors. Passes will be issued and **MUST** be shown upon request.

BSPA ROYAL INTERNATIONAL HORSE SHOW QUALIFIERS 2012

Skewbald and Piebald Horses only may compete. All Horses/Ponies must be Registered with BSPA in order to compete and a competitor qualification card issued prior to this show.

Classes 20 -26 incl. are held under the rules and requirements of the BSPA, refer showing card. **1 class only may be entered.**

Qualification RIHS: 1st place and the next unqualified competitor standing 2nd or 3rd in all classes. No competitor may qualify from lower than third place. Qualification cards MUST be brought into the ring by riders and given to the judge to sign whilst rosettes are being awarded. Failure to present Q card invalidates any qualification, which is handed down in the ring to the next unqualified competitor standing no lower than 3rd place.

Also Qualifies for BSPA/ WCC: 1-3 in all classes.

Class 20: RIHS Skewbald/Piebald Pony any Type not to exceed 143cms.

Any type or sex, 4 years old and over, rider any age suitable for size of pony.

Class 21: RIHS Skewbald/Piebald Plaited Pony exceeding 143cms not to exceed 153cms.

Any type or sex, 4 years old and over, rider any age, suitable size for pony.

Class 22: RIHS Skewbald/Piebald Traditional/Native/Cob Pony exceeding 143cms not to exceed 153cms.

Any type, sex, 4 years old and over, rider any age, suitable size for pony.

Class 23: RIHS Skewbald/Piebald Plaited Lightweight Horses exceeding 153cms.

Any Type or sex. Riders 15yrs and older as January 1st '12.

Class 24: RIHS Skewbald/Piebald Plaited Middleweight & Heavyweight Horses exceeding 153cms.

Any Type or sex. Riders 15yrs and older as January 1st '12.

Class 25: RIHS Skewbald/Piebald.

Heavyweight/Traditional/Native/Cob Horses exceeding 153cms.

Any Type or sex. Riders 15yrs and older as January 1st '12.

Class 26:**RIHS Section Championship.**

First and Second from classes 20 - 25 incl. Compete.

Award: Section Champion and Reserve Champion.

**BRITISH SHOW HORSE ASSOCIATION
ROYAL INTERNATIONAL HORSE SHOW AND BSHA NATIONAL
CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFIERS:**

Classes 27 – 42 are held under the rules and jurisdiction of the British Show Horse Association (BSHA). Copies of rules to be obtained from them.

RIHS qualifying classes: Held under the rules of the BSHA. Horses must be registered with the Association and all owners, exhibitors and riders must be Association members. Riders must be 15 years of age and over. Classes 31,32,34,35,37,38 & 40 are qualifiers for the Royal International Horse Show. The first prize winner will qualify to compete at the final. If already qualified the second will qualify, if the first and second are already qualified then the third will go forward.

The three highest placed prize winners in all open affiliated classes will qualify to compete in the BSHA Classic Supreme Classes at the National Championship Show September 7th & 8th.

The BSHA offer a Novice, Young Rider and Amateur rosette in each open class and a Championship rosette for each section.

ENTRIES ON THE DAY: will be taken on the payment of an additional £20 per class and the production of **ALL relevant documentation** as above.

Class 27: Novice Hack.

Mare or Gelding, 4 years & over. Exceeding 148cms not exceeding 160cms.

Class 28: Novice Riding Horse.

Mare or Gelding, 4 years & over. Exceeding 148cms.

Class 29: Novice Cob.

Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over exceeding 148cms.

See BSHA Rule Book for definition of Novice. Horses may be shown in a snaffle. Non-members may purchase up to a maximum of 2 Day Tickets per exhibitor, per horse per season. A day ticket will allow entry into Novice,

affiliated classes only but will not allow entry into RIHS qualifying classes. Horses registered on a day ticket do not require a JMB height certificate. Competitors can apply for a day ticket by downloading an application form from the BSHA website.

Class 30: Novice Championship.

First and second from Classes 27 & 29 to compete.

Award: Champion and Reserve.

Class 31: Small Hack - RIHS Qualifier.

Mare or Gelding, 4 years & over. Exceeding 148cms not exceeding 154cms.

Class 32: Large Hack - RIHS Qualifier.

Mare or Gelding, 4 years & over. Exceeding 154cms not exceeding 160cms.

Class 33: Hack Championship.

First and second from Classes 31 & 32 to compete.

Award: Champion and Reserve.

Class 34: Small Riding Horse. - RIHS Qualifier.

Mare or gelding 4 years old and over exceeding 148cms. Not exceeding 158cms.

Class 35: Large Riding Horse - RIHS Qualifier.

Mare or gelding 4 years old and over exceeding 158cms.

Class 36: Riding Horse Championship.

First and second from Classes 34 & 35 to compete.

Award: Champion and Reserve.

Class 37: Lightweight Show Cob - RIHS Qualifier.

Mare or gelding, 4years old and over exceeding 148cms and not exceeding 155cms capable of carrying up to 14 stone.

Class 38: Heavyweight Show Cob - RIHS Qualifier.

Mare or gelding, 4years old and over exceeding 148cms and not exceeding 155cms capable of carrying over 14 stone.

Class 39: Cob Championship.

First and Second from Classes 37 & 38 to compete.

Award: Champion and Reserve.

Class 40: Maxi Cob – RIHS Qualifier.

Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 155cms to be judged as Cobs. Judges will pay particular attention to Type (i.e. short legged animals of COB type). To be shown hogged.

Class 41: BSHA Championship.
Champions/Reserve Champions Classes 33, 36 and 39 compete.
Award: Section Champion and Reserve.

Class 42: The P(UK) Kempley Ridden Cob.

Open ridden cob 4 years and over. Mare or Gelding, exceeding 148cms not exceeding 155cms. Riders to have attained their 15th birthday by Jan 1st .

The 1st, 2nd and 3rd in class 41 will qualify for THE P(UK) Kempley Ridden Cob Championship.
