Class 2 Q	<b>OPEN YOUNGSTOCK</b> Born 2009, 2010 or 2012. Any type, height, sex or colour. Qualifiers for three highest placed not exceeding 153cms at maturity and those to exceed 153cms at maturity
Class 3 Q	<b>TRADITIONAL COB</b> any height or age or sex to be shown in natural state. a. Under 13 hands (133 cms) b. Over 13 hands not exceeding 14 hands (143cms) c. Over 14 hands (143cms) Will be split if sufficient entries. Special to highest placed young stock
Class 4Q	<b>OPEN HEAVYWEIGHTS/ HOGGEDCOBS / VANNERS</b> Any age, type, height, sex. Special to highest placed young stock.
Class 5Q	<b>PLAITED HORSE</b> exceeding 153cms Any age, type, sex. Special to highest placed young stock.

Judged in three categories yearling, two year old, three year old. Colts and Fillies  
only

# **RULES**

Classes will be judged within the rules and criteria of the B.S.P.A, copies can be obtained from them. Please note that you do not have to be a member to compete but you must hold a current membership/horse registration to qualify for the Summer Championships.

1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> or three highest placed in open classes to qualify.

All Qualification cards **MUST** be signed in the ring by the class judge in order to be valid..

The Brightwells Auctioneers Skewbald and Piebald Sports Horse and Pony In Hand National Championship Qualifier. These classes are for athletic Horses and Ponies that have the conformation and movement to compete in Dressage, Show jumping or Eventing and that have a **verified/proven parentage passport, breeding must be indicated on the entry form.** The three highest places in each class to qualify for the final to be held at the British Skewbald and Piebald Association World Championships of Colour August 2012 At the final the Champion will receive £ 50 the Reserve £ 20 Each Horse/Pony is to be judged individually on a triangle and also walked and trotted round the ring as a class. Marks will be awarded for confirmation, walk, trot and overall impression. **Handlers, Owners and Horses/Ponies must be members of the BSPA for qualification to remain valid. These classes are open to BSPA Members with registered Horses/Ponies only.**

**Classes 15 – 19** These classes are affiliated to the British Skewbald and Piebald Association and are qualifiers for the Royal International Horse Show at Hickstead on Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> July 2012. These classes will be judged under BSPA rules, copies of which can be obtained from them. All horses/ponies must be registered with and owners & riders members of BSPA prior to the show. Rider age is taken as 1<sup>st</sup> Jan. All stallions must be graded and licensed by BSPA. No rider under 14yrs may exhibit a stallion in any class. Membership and Qualification cards **MUST** be carried in the ring by competitors and produced as required for inspection and signature. Failure to do so will disqualify any competitor and their qualification handed down to the next unqualified competitor. Spurs may not be worn in any pony class. Ponies 153cms or under must possess a current JMB height certificate. Qualification: 1<sup>st</sup> place and the highest next unqualified competitor standing 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> qualify from each class. No competitor may qualify from lower than 3<sup>rd</sup> place.

1. Competitors and spectators attend the show at their own risk. The organisers will not be held responsible for any accident, damage, loss or injury to any person, animal or property whatsoever.
2. The judge's decision is FINAL.
3. No entries to be refunded.
4. No lunging in the collecting ring.
5. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry without explanation.
6. Any horse, pony, handler or rider behaving in any way that poses a risk to itself or others will be asked to leave.
7. All colts/stallions must be bitted. NO EXCEPTIONS, STALLIONS 4 YEARS AND OVER MUST BE GRADED WITH BSPA.
8. Horses/ponies in ridden classes must be 4 years old and over unless otherwise stated in the schedule
9. Horse/ponies ages are from 1 January
10. Junior riders must wear correctly secured British Standard Riding Hats as EN1384.PAS015 or PAS accredited.
11. Skewbald/Piebald colts/stallions aged 4yrs and over must be licensed or graded with the B.S.P.A to go in showing classes. No rider or handler under 14yrs may exhibit a colt/stallion.
12. Owners/Handlers/Riders/Horses must be members/registered with B.S.P.A to qualify but need not to enter (except classes 8 + 17-22 when membership horse registration is required)
13. Spurs must not be worn in any Ridden Pony class.
14. Dressage whips are forbidden and all whips must be under 30 inches
15. No mucking out into the car park
16. No smoking in arena
17. No dogs except in horsebox area
18. Mobile phones must be turned off in the ring
19. No earrings, tongue studs, or any jewellery may be worn whilst competing
